ST. CHRISTOPHER MAGALLANES & COMPANIONS



The church celebrates the Memorial the St. Christopher Magallanes, priest and martyr, and his companions. Cristobal and his twenty-four companion martyrs lived under a very anti-Catholic government in Mexico, one determined to weaken the Catholic faith of its people. Churches, schools and seminaries were closed; foreign clergy were expelled. Cristobal established a clandestine seminary at Totatiche, Jalisco. Magallanes and the other priest were forced to minister secretly to Catholics during the presidency of Plutarco Calles (1924-1928).

All of these martyrs except three were diocesan priests. David, Manuel and Salvador were laymen who died with his parish priest. All of these martyrs belonged to the Cristero movement, pledging their allegiance to Christ and to the church that he established to spread the Good News in society-even if Mexico's leaders had made it a crime to receive baptism or celebrate the Mass. The martyrs did not die as a single group but in eight Mexican states, with Jalisco and Zacatecas having the largest number. They were beatified in 1992 and canonized by Pope John Paul II in 2000. Feast day: May 21.

Born in the town of Roccaporena in the province of Umbria, Italy, she was married and raised her twin sons. After the murder of her husband, she urged forgiveness rather than the customary vendetta. She was denied entrance to the Augustinian convent because of the threat of violent revenge by her husband's relatives. Through her intercession a promise of forgiveness and peace was secured and she began forty years of austerities, contemplation and service to the sick and poor. Toward the end of her life, she bore a wounds as from a thorn after having heard a sentence about the Crown of Thorns.

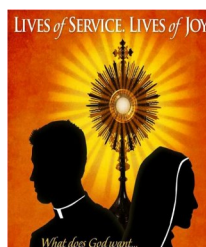

El Recibimiento Apropiado de la Comunión en la Mano

Claramente la persona que se disponga a recibir la Comunión debe estar en armonía con Dios y haber recibido el sacramento de la Confesión. Camine en la fila de Comunión con sus manos unidas en oración (no a los lados). Inclínese al llegar frente al sacerdote, para respetar el Cuerpo de Cristo que esta en sus manos. Forma un trono digno con tus manos, con tu mano derecha debajo de la otra palma. Cuando el sacerdote o Diacono diga **“El Cuerpo de Cristo”**, responda audiblemente **“Amen”** (*esta palabra significa que crees en la transustanciación, que estas recibiendo el Cuerpo y Sangre de Jesucristo, no es un símbolo*). Coloca con reverencia la hostia en tu boca inmediatamente o camine tres o dos pies, deténgase por complete y mirando al altar consuma la hostia. Continúe caminando regrese a su banco con las manos juntas en oración y no en los costados, arrodíllese y continúe en oración.

PENTECOSTÉS
